OER have no cost to students and are available on the first day of class.
- · Low-Cost Textbooks: Required textbooks and/or other course materials that cost the student a total of \$30 or less (excluding special course fees) per class and may be purchased at the CWI Bookstore.

Please note that not all sections of a particular course will utilize OER, as notated in the table below. Students can verify that a specific section uses OER or low-cost textbooks by looking for the following symbol next to the section listing in Student Planning at the time of registration:
