    2 Lewis-Clark State College and University of Idaho require two (2) years of a language, so students may choose to take the first semester of a language for their GEM 5 requirement, provided the transfer institution also offers that course. In that case, GEM 5 should be delayed until a student's final semester.
    3 Course must come from a different discipline.
    4 Students need to complete a two-course sequence of English literature survey courses. For example, if the student elects to take ENGL 267 Survey of British Literature I in order to complete their GEM 5 requirement, they need to complete the sequence by taking ENGL 268 Survey of British Literature II in a later semester. If they elect to take ENGL 277 Survey of American Literature I, they need to complete the sequence by taking ENGL 278 Survey of American Literature II in a later semester. Please Note: The literature sequences do not need to be taken in orderstudents may take ENGL 268, then ENGL 267.
