Program Description

The Associate of Arts in Social Work is designed for students who plan to transfer to a baccalaureate social work program. The degree meets general education requirements at Idaho public universities and provides a foundation in social work values, ethics, and generalist practice concepts aligned with Council for Social Work Education (CSWE) standards used by accredited baccalaureate programs.

Coursework introduces students to culturally responsive practice, social welfare policy, human rights and social justice, social work theory, research-informed practice, and the helping process. Through classroom instruction and applied learning experiences, students develop an understanding of social work roles, systems, and professional expectations.

Graduates are prepared to continue their education in social work or related fields and may pursue entry-level or support roles in a wide range of social service settings, including community-based organizations, nonprofit agencies, health and human services programs, schools, and public service systems. Students are encouraged to work closely with an academic advisor to ensure course selection aligns with requirements of their intended transfer institution.
